Survive the wilderness Green incentive in Nuuksio

Just a 45 minutes drive away from Helsinki city centre, you can enter the wilderness. The National Park of Nuuksio, established in 1994, is the most extensive and ecologically important continuous backwoods area in this region.

The national park is a great destination for ecological incentives. Here your group will be trained how to survive in the wilderness, enjoy a lunch by a camp fire and finally hunt for a treasure on water.

How would you survive in the wilderness? Your skills will be evaluated in the nature, as you show how you shoot with archery, set a fire and an ambush. You will also be taught how you catch fish.

No matter whether you were lucky with your fishing or not - you will enjoy a good lumberjack's lunch on a camp fire, finishing with coffee from thermos bottle.

After lunch you will start searching for a treasure. The small trolls have hidden a valuable treasure, which can only be reached by waters. The trolls have left small hints, which you have to solve together with your team mates. You are floating safely in rubber rafts. Each raft can take five to seven persons. Good communication with your team mates is crucial to find the treasure!

All these activities are not only run in the forest – they are also environmentally friendly.
