Medieval Adventure in Nelahozeves Back to the middle ages!

Nelahozeves castle

The monumental castle of Nelahozeves, one of the finest Bohemian Renaissance castle is located 25 kilometres north of Prague, high above the Vltava River.

Nelahozeves castle is an example of the castello fortezza, a style deemed very modern around 1550. The castle builder Florian Griespeck, a well educated aristocrat, served as private secretary and close adviser to Emperor Ferdinand I. In 1623, the castle was purchased by Princess Polyxena Lobkowitz and has been owned by the family ever since. After the overthrow of Communism the castle was returned to the Lobkowitz family in 1993. The castle interior was re-installed with historical period rooms, depicting the lifestyle and objects with which different Lobkowitz Princes and Princesses lived through the centuries. This is

now a permanent exhibition entitled "Private Spaces: A Noble Family at Home".

Programme:

Upon arrival you will be welcomed by fanfares played by costumed trumpeters at the castle windows. Waiters will serve welcome drinks; you will have an opportunity to see the period fencers fighting, medieval dancers, jugglers, conjurers and of course live music. You can try your artistic skills by making small handmade crafts, such as wiring baskets, making candles, decorating gingerbread, minting coins and painting the coat-of arms. Watching a horse tournament can also be arranged.
